Kitchen Renovation Project

The Kitchen Project has begun! Demolition of the kitchen in the Norris Building is underway, and the sink has been removed. Following the church service on Sunday, February 1, all items remaining in the kitchen will be removed to another location in the church.

Demolition of the walls and cabinets begins the first week in February.

After delivery, the new appliances, along with other items, will be stored in the Children's Classroom.

The Norris Building will be usable during most of the renovation project; there will just be less space available for meetings.

However, once the change-out of the existing carpeting for the new flooring begins, the building will be temporarily unusable.

The project should be completed by Easter, April 5.
